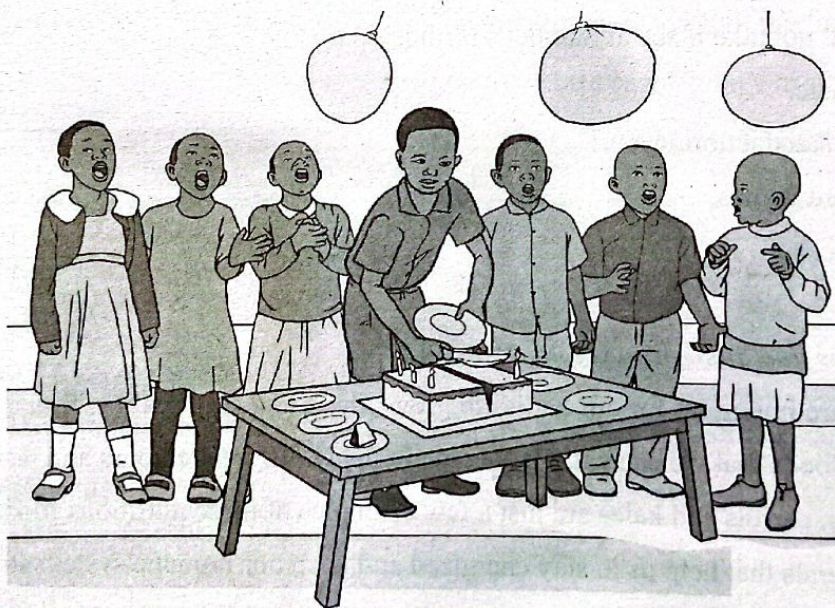


- Samuel** : (Knocking at the door) Excuse me sir, may I come in?
